# Lunchbox Checklist for Food Brought from Home for 2 to 5 year olds 

A Guide for Families
Use this checklist to help provide nutritious food each day your child is in care for eight hours or more. This usually includes morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. The recommended number of serves from each food group, while in care, is provided below.

| Examples: <br> - 3 wholegrain crispbreads <br> - $1 / 2$ bread roll <br> - $1 / 2$ pita pocket bread <br> - $1 / 2$ fruit muffin <br> - 2 thick rice cakes <br> - 3 corn thins <br> - 1 slice fruit loaf <br> - 5 water crackers <br> - 2 pikelets <br> - 1 small fruit scone <br> - 10 rice crackers <br> - $1 / 2$ cup cooked pasta spirals <br> *Choose wholegrain or high cereal fibre varieties. | Examples: <br> - 1 medium banana <br> - 1 medium bunch of grapes <br> - 2 mandarins <br> - 2 kiwi fruit <br> - 1 medium orange <br> - $11 / 2$ tablespoons sultanas <br> - 1 medium pear <br> - 2 small apricots <br> - 2 small plums <br> - 4 dried apricot halves <br> - 6 large strawberries | Examples: <br> - $1 / 2$ corn cob <br> - $1 / 2$ cup green beans <br> - $1 / 2$ medium potato <br> - 1 cup cucumber sticks <br> - 1 cup halved cherry tomatoes <br> - 1 cup carrot sticks <br> - $1 / 2$ cup broccoli florets <br> - $1 / 2$ cup 4 bean mix <br> - $1 / 4$ cup hommus | Examples: <br> - 250ml plain milk <br> - 200g fruit yoghurt <br> - 3/4 cup custard <br> - 1 cheese triangle/ wedge <br> - 2 slices of cheese <br> * Choose mostly reduced fat milk and dairy products for children over 2 years of age. | Example: <br> - 3/4 cup baked beans <br> - 50 g lean ham <br> - $1 / 4$ chicken breast in strips <br> - 2 small meatballs <br> - 2 medium boiled eggs <br> - 1 chicken drumstick <br> - 1 small 75 g tin tuna or salmon <br> - 1 slice of cold roast meat <br> - 130 g tofu |

## Please don't send these foods:

- Sticky snacks like some health food bars, muesli bars, lollies and fruit straps as these may cause tooth decay.
- Foods high in fat and sugar like sweet, cream-filled and chocolate-coated biscuits, chocolate and chocolate or yoghurt coated health food bars.
- Foods high in fat and salt like chips and savoury snack biscuits.
